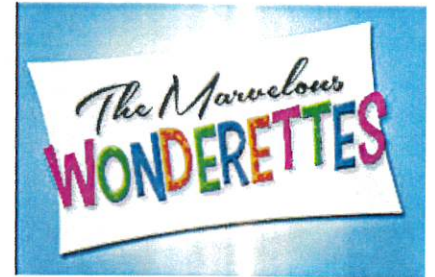
July 15-26
